FEATURED SAINT: Saint Casimir, Patron of Lithuania

Born: 3rd October 1458 / Died: 4th March 1484 (Aged 25)

St Casimir is the Patron Saint of Poland and Lithuania. This image from the main cathedral of Lithuania depicts Casimir with two right hands as a sign of his great generosity to the poor. He holds a rosary, a sign of his life of prayer and devotion to Mary, and a lily, which signifies his purity and innocence. He became known for his piety, devotion to God and generosity to sick and poor.
