FEATURED SAINT: Bede the Venerable

Born: c. 673 England / Died: 26th May 735, England

St Bede occupies an important niche in Church history by bridging the gap between patristic and early medieval times, the era when the Germanic has just been Christianized. He is also honored as the “father of the English history”. His writings were read publicly in churches while he was still alive, since he could not be called “Saint”, the title of Venerable was attached to his name.
