Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, Solemnity

The Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is one of the most widely practiced and well-known devotions in the Roman Catholic Church. It takes the physical heart of Jesus as representation of His Divine love for humanity. The Feast of the Sacred Heart has been in the Roman Catholic Liturgical calendar since 1856 and is always celebrated 19 days after Pentecost Sunday. The feast calls on a Friday. The devotion especially emphasizes the unmitigated love, compassion and long suffering of the heart of Christ towards humanity. The origin of the devotion to the Most Sacred Heart in the modern form, derived for a French Roman Catholic Saint, St. Marguerite Marie Alacoque, who learned the devotion from Jesus during mystical experience.

Over recent weeks, all the parishes in the diocese have chosen to cease paying insurance and begin paying into a 'self-insurance' fund. Parish Finance Committees recognize that the new fund is not a 'like-for-like' fund and that in most cases a church or parish building would not be rebuilt. Thank you to everyone who has participated in this discussion. Please note: Our parish buildings will no longer be insured from 31 May 2024. Your Parish Finance Committee will be working through a Disaster Management Plan to make sure that everyone is clear from the beginning what buildings and eventualities will be covered by the new 'self-insurance' fund.
