Born: 9th January 1902 / Died: 26th June 1975

St Jose Maria Escriva De Balaguer was a Roman Catholic priest from Spain who initiated Opus Dei, an organization of lay people and priests dedicated to the teaching that everyone is called to holiness by God and the ordinary life can result in sanctity. He was canonised in 2002 by Pope John Paul II, who declared St Jose Maria should be "counter among the great witnesses of Christianity."
