**Featured Saint: Saint Aloysius Gonzaga**

**Born: 8<sup>th</sup> March 1568 / Died: 21<sup>st</sup> June 1591**

Saint Aloysius Gonzaga's outstanding quality was his radiant purity. The Church praises this perfect innocence with the words, "Thou has made him little less than the angels." He was baptised in the womb because his life was in danger, and he made a vow of chastity at the age of nine. He joined the Society of Jesus at the age of 16 and he worked fearlessly among the plague-stricken people. At the age of 23 he died because of his devoted nursing of the plague victims.
