Born: 15th August 1195 / Died: 13th June 1231

Saint Anthony of Padua was a Portuguese Catholic priest and friar of the Franciscan Order. He both as a Theologian and as a popular preacher fought vigorously against heresy. His preaching was inspired by the love of God and souls' and had an extraordinary power of conviction; it was filled with the penetrating power of the Bible. He says, "preach the Gospel" to everyone you see but "use words when needed". He is the patron saint of lost or misplaced things.

Building Awesome Whānau Course

Building Awesome Whānau draws on the wisdom of Māori kaupapa (values) which is uniquely Aotearoa. Packed full of great ideas and positive stories from parents still on the journey with their own tamariki (children) with practical ideas to help those you work with.

This course is ideal for all families from parents, extended family and friends raising kids together. The course runs for a total of 8 weeks with 6 different sessions of topics, covering things like 'Foundations of Aroha', 'Parents and Whānau as the roof', 'Walls of the whare, and 'Keeping it sweet'. The cost for this course is \$20 per person and runs for 2 hours during winter in the daytime and summertime in the evenings

SPACE Pēpē & Parent Course

SPACE is parenting classes aimed mostly at first time parents with all the babies in a class being around a similar age, so they potentially have similar stages of developments happening. We meet weekly over two school terms in length (20 weeks in total with a mid-break). Each week we meet, we have a topic of discussion, sharing our ideas, questions and support for each other. Topics might be becoming a parent, attunement, brain development, sleep, movement, going back to work, nutrition, parenting styles and more. We try and have songs, stories, craft each week and sometimes some speakers from the community. The cost for this course is \$50 per term you attend and runs for 2 hours during the day on a Tuesday.
