## Feature Saint: Saint Dominic Savio

## Born: 2<sup>nd</sup> April 1842 / Died: 9<sup>th</sup> March 1857

Dominic Savio was an Italian adolescent student of Saint John Bosco. While he was studying to be a priest, he became ill and died at the age of 14. He is the youngest non-martyr to be canonized in the Catholic Church. On the day of his first communion, Dominic wrote four promises in a little book. 1. I will go to Confession often, 2. I wish to sanctify the Sundays and festivals in a special manner, 3. My friends shall be Jesus and Mary, 4. Death rather than sin.
