

of belief, but Thomas was equally courageous, willing to stand by Jesus in dangerous times. He also relentlessly sought the Truth. Like an inquisitive child, he constantly asked questions. And, his wonderful professing, "My Lord and my God", is the clearest declaration of Jesus' divinity. Saint Thomas is venerated as the Apostles of India, and the Feast of Saint Thomas on 3<sup>rd</sup> July is celebrated as Indian Christians' Day. He built seven churches and was martyred during his prayers by a spear on the "Big Hill" near Madras, India. The name Thomas remains guite popular among the Saint Thomas Christians of the Indian subcontinent.
